Priory Sailing Club has a very impressive record for junior training and safety. It is a RYA OnBoard Centre, RYA Training Centre and RYA Volvo Champion Club. It runs a number of junior programmes on Saturdays, Sundays and during the school holidays.

**Saturday Afternoon Pirates** is open to all children wishing to learn to sail and advance through the RYA's youth training scheme. Join in the beginners sessions if you are new to sailing, and follow the RYA Stage 1 course syllabus. Pirate sessions also offer the chance for huge amounts of fun, with games as well as tuition from qualified instructors.

**Saturday Afternoon Advanced Pirates** sessions are for children who already have successfully completed RYA Stage 1. Training progresses to Stage 2 level, but there is still 'loads a' fun to accompany the learning

**Sunday Buccaneers** When you are confident in sailing you may wish to progress to Buccaneers to learn dinghy racing. Buccaneers practice on Sunday afternoons and eventually you may be invited to join the Priory Volvo Champion Race Development Squad / Team

**In the past we have had the flexibility to welcome all who came to Priory without prior booking. However, as the programmes and in particular Pirates have become so popular, and because we are limited in numbers by safety, pre booking is essential to avoid disappointment.**

## **This part of the membership form outlines your obligations as parents / guardians.**

Your Childs Safety is important to you and is as equally very important to us, please read the following as it contains vital information.

### **Junior Instruction & Supervision**

It is important to understand that whilst your child / ward is a junior member of Priory Sailing Club and may sail at other times. However it is very important to note that the Instruction Team can only provide instruction at the times and dates agreed in our programmes.

A parent / responsible adult **MUST** remain on site with children under 14 or children who do not hold RYA Stage 3 during sessions. Assistance with getting equipment out, rigging craft and putting equipment away will be welcomed.

### **LAKE SAFETY**

Members must wear a buoyancy aid *at all times* whilst on the water and follow P.S.C. Sailing Rules. The Club will endeavour to ensure that:

- there is a First Aid Kit and blanket in the ground floor (wet) training room.
- there is a Survival bag on the Safety Boat.

There is also an emergency telephone in the **green box** on the outside wall by the downstairs wet training room of the building.

**Photography** of both adults and young people may take place at Priory Water Sports Centre. Where photographs of young people under the age of 18 are shown either in the club house or on the web then sensible child protection guidelines will be used. If photographs are going to be used in press releases then parental permission will be sought first.

**Changing Rooms** -We would like to draw to your attention that the changing rooms at the Priory Water Sports Centre have limited space and are used by both adults and young people often at the same time.

**Insurance** – If you decide to purchase a boat for your child then you will need to undertake to ensure that any craft used by your family or guests at Priory Lake is insured against Third Party and Passenger Risks for a minimum of £2,000,000, and agree to produce evidence of such cover when required. The Club insurance only covers the use of club boats by club members except for training courses.

**Membership Records** - I agree that membership records for myself and my family may be stored and processed electronically in accordance with the Data Protection Act. It should be noted that Junior Members details are not made available to the general members but are available to Committee Members Only.
