To assist in the preparation of the rota please indicate on the OOD duty sheet two alternative dates when you could do your OOD duty period of 4 hours. Sunday pm, Saturday am/pm, Bank Holiday am/pm. The security and well being of the club depends upon these duties. However, if you do wish to opt out, one of our younger, but over age 16, members will be able to deputise for you for a fee of £25:00. Please enclose fee with your subscription. Please let Tony Ogborn (01234 708010) know if you swap duties with another member or cannot attend on the date agreed or allocated. The completed OOD Rota will appear in the clubhouse. If you fail to attend your OOD Duty the Club reserves the right to invoice you the OOD opt out fee of £25.00.

LAKE SAFETY

Members must wear a buoyancy aid *at all times* whilst on the water and follow P.S.C. Sailing Rules. The Club will endeavour to ensure that:
there is a First Aid Kit and blanket in the ground floor (wet) training room.
there is a Survival bag on the Safety Boat.

There is also an emergency telephone in the **green box** on the outside wall by the downstairs wet training room of the building.

Photography of both adults and young people may take place at Priory Water Sports Centre. Where photographs of young people under the age of 18 are shown either in the club house or on the web then sensible child protection guidelines will be used. If photographs are going to be used in press releases then parental permission will be sought first.

Changing Rooms -We would like to draw to your attention that the changing rooms at the Priory Water Sports Centre have limited space and are used by both adults and young people often at the same time.

Insurance - I undertake to ensure that any craft used by me, my family or guests at Priory Lake is insured against Third Party and Passenger Risks for a minimum of £2,000,000, and agree to produce evidence of such cover when required. The Club insurance only covers the use of club boats by club members except for training courses.

Membership Records - I agree that membership records for myself and my family may be stored and processed electronically in accordance with the Data Protection Act.
