**CLUB DUTIES**

Each adult member of the club is required to assist in the smooth operation of the club by completing at least one duty per year. Families and couples carry out two duties. These duties can be either as Officer of the Day (OOD), whose tasks are summarised on the club’s website, or as a safety boat driver. Safety boat drivers need to be approved members of the Safety Boat team, having qualified to RYA PB 2 standard and been trained in the use of club Safety Boats.

The schedule of duties is managed using Dutyman software. This allows members to select suitable dates on which to complete their duties. The software also manages swaps, in case members need to change the date which they originally selected.

The security and well-being of the club depends upon these duties. Members can opt out of these duties, in exchange for a fee of £25. Please enclose the fee with your subscription.

The club will allocate two dates for OOD to any members who have not opted out, and who have not selected two dates on Dutyman. If a member does not attend an OOD Duty on the day they have selected or been allocated, the Club reserves the right to invoice the member the OOD opt out fee of £25.00.

**LAKE SAFETY**

Members must wear a buoyancy aid *at all times* whilst on the water and follow P.S.C. Sailing Rules. The Club will endeavour to ensure that there is a First Aid Kit and blanket in the ground floor (wet) training room and a Survival bag on the Safety Boat.

There is also an emergency telephone 999 only in the **green box** on the outside wall by the downstairs wet training room of the building.

**Changing Rooms** -We would like to draw to your attention that the changing rooms at the Priory Water Sports Centre have limited space and are used by both adults and young people often at the same time.

**Insurance** - I undertake to ensure that any craft used by me, my family or guests at Priory Lake is insured against Third Party and Passenger Risks for a minimum of £2,000,000, and agree to produce evidence of such cover when required. The Club insurance only covers the use of club craft by club members and their guests and for training courses.

**DATA PROTECTION**
