MEMBERS USE OF CLUB CRAFT AND EQUIPMENT

Club Members, at their own risk, may use club craft and equipment when an Officer of the Day is on duty. Please remember that all scheduled club training courses, including dinghy Pirates, Buccaneers and windsurfing training have first call on club craft and equipment.

Please ask the Officer of the Day or a Committee Member for help if you are in doubt.

Please look after all club equipment and ensure it is put away after use. Please record any damage on the whiteboard in the green container.

DINGHIES FOR GENERAL USE

Children U-14	9 x Oppi Dinghies	Parental supervision is mandatory.
All members	9 x Blue / Yellow Toppers Foils stored in boats. Masts stored in green container.	Foils, boats and trolleys marked with blue or yellow paint. Topper masts marked with yellow paint are full size sails and those marked with red paint are smaller training sails.
All members	9 x Laser Picos Masts and foils in ground floor store	Foils, mast bases and boats unmarked.

DINGHES FOR EXPERIENCED DINGHY SAILORS ONLY

(If you are unsure if your experience is appropriate for the craft or conditions please seek advice)

Experienced sailors under 18 for racing/race training only	9 x Purple Toppers Masts stored in green container. Foils stored in boats.	Foils, masts, boats, and trolleys all marked with mauve paint.
Suitably experienced members.	Topper Omega x 3, Hartley 15 x 3, Laser Radial x 6, Topper Vibe, Heron. Racing sails for Picos.	
Please note that our Vibe, Omegas and Hartley 15s have spinnakers. These are exciting sails to use but are particularly vulnerable to damage through misuse and therefore should only be used by those with appropriate experience and training. Also note that our Heron and Laser Radials are more prone to hull damage as they are made from glassfibre rather than the more robust plastics of most of our other craft. Please sail with care!
